OUTDOOR POOL:

The members discussed pool chair samples that were brought to the outdoor pool to look at and more will be given to all to see. No decision right now and hopefully next season the Board will approve the purchase of new chairs. Kieve stated that we now have chairs 14 inches high and would look at chairs 18 inches high-easier to get in and out of-16 ½ inches with handles is industry standard.

Some of the residents requested a working water fountain-a recommendation was made to refurbish water fountain near bathrooms by the pool.

A request was made by residents to have 1-2 lap lanes roped off in the late afternoons-need to purchase ropes and install hooks-a recommendation was made to have this completed next season.

We spoke about the cleanliness of the pool this season and it was discussed that between a very hot summer, chemicals get sucked out with heat, one pump went down, debris in pool and testing kit was black. We have to be realistic that the lifeguards are trying their best to keep the pool clean. We will keep our eye on this and maybe also recommend cleaning time for pool. Also discussed extended pools hours for next year.

INDOOR POOL:

Request Stephanie that when she sends out pool hours for the winter that she include a message that children playing on the lane ropes have again broken the rope and that residents should instruct their guests not to hang on the ropes.

Volleyball sign-correct sign to reflect being open on Wednesdays, as they no longer play on Wednesdays.

Kieve suggested committee members draw up their own "reasonable" recommendation for outdoor pool guest policies in light of 100 new families and bring the recommendations to the next meeting.

Also we discussed committee members being present at the pool to observe more closely the daily operation and any potential breaches of pool regulations.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:00 am and the next pool committee meeting is November 3rd at 10:00 am.
