OLD BUSINESS

NEW BUSINESS

There was a suggestion that all public areas of the clubhouse, where games are being played, should be cell phone free, and signs should be erected stating that. A vote was taken and was 5 to 1 in favor of implementing the signs.

A total of 8 outside guests will be allowed after prime time. However, residents will always have first play priority. Usage will be according to a schedule.
